

**Over the summer, we'd like you to complete two creative tasks.**

### **Task 1: Make a Concertina Book**

We'd like you to create an A5 concertina book with at least 6 pages. You can fill the pages with anything you like, but here are a few things to think about:

- **Paper choice** – It doesn't have to be plain white paper. Could you recycle something? Does it even need to be paper at all?
- **Materials** – Use whatever you fancy: pens, pencils, paint, ink, crayons – anything goes.
- **Techniques** – You might want to work digitally, use photography, or mix a bunch of different styles and skills.
- **Construction** – Think carefully about how you'll put your concertina book together. The more attention you give to the details, the better the final result will be.
- **Pages** – 6 is the minimum, but feel free to do more if you're feeling inspired.
- **Content** – This is your space to be creative. We want to see you in the work – your ideas, your style, your voice.

### **Task 2: Mood Board & 500 Words**

Create a PowerPoint mood board and write around 500 words about your creative hero or passion. This could be:

- A person (artist, designer, etc.)
- A movement or theory
- A technique, material, or object
- Or even something that inspires and motivates you – like music, nature, or a personal experience

Please avoid choosing the usual suspects like Picasso, Van Gogh, Da Vinci, or any other old, dead white male artists. We're encouraging you to dig a bit deeper and explore voices and influences that are fresh, diverse, and maybe even underrepresented.

The aim is to help us – and your classmates – get to know what drives your creativity.
