## 1. Watch a musical of your choice.

## 2. Research the musical you have watched.

Consider:

- When was it created?
- Who wrote the score and lyrics?
- Who choreographed it?
- What is it based on?
- Why was it created? Was there anything going on at the time which might have influenced it?

**3. Create a presentation to share with us in your first lesson.**

This should include:

- Title, date and venue of musical seen
- Research information from task 2
- Your own review of the work – including discussion of your favourite scene/song/dance and what was most effective about it.
